Maybe of Interest - Fixtures Since 1970

Between 1970 and 1990 there were between 15 and 22 fixtures per season

Between 1991 and 1997 between 19 and 24 (1994) fixtures per season, and

Since 2002 between 10 and 13 fixtures per season.

Between 1970 and 1997 there were between 6 and 10 fixtures against Welsh clubs, and in the 1990's there were between 6 and 8 fixtures against Old Boy School sides.
